Baret & John Coleman Gentlemen Justices of the Court of Amherst County now sitting and to their successors in office in the sum \$ _____ current money of Virginia to which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves our heirs & jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 21st day of January 1822 in the 46th year of the Commonwealth The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the said Richard N. Eubank Admr^s of the goods chattles and credits of Archibud Mitchel Dec^d do make a true and perfect Inventory of all and singular the goods chattles and credits of the said Deceased which have or shall come to the hands possession or Knowledge of him the said Richard Eubank or in the hands possession or Knowledge of any other person or persons for him and the same so made do exhibit to the County Court of Amherst when he shall be thereunto required by the said Court and the said goods chattles and credits do well and truly Administer according to law and further do make a just and true account of all actings and doings when thereto required by the said Court and all of the said goods Chattles and credits remaining upon the account of the said Administrator the same being first examined and allowed by the Justices of said County for the time being shall deliver unto such persons respectively as are entitled to the same by law and if it shall hereafter appear that any last Will and Testament was made by the ^{Dec^d} Executor and the same be proven in Court and the Executor obtain a certificate of the probate thereof and the said R. N. Eubank in such case being required render and deliver up letters of Administration then this obligation to be void else to remain in full force
