Frank Owen White, 66, for many years engaged in farming in Bedford County and widely known in Lynchburg, where he marketed his products, died yesterday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock at the home of W. F. Reburn, Route 1, Lynchburg, where he had been ill for about two years.

Funeral plans had not been completed late yesterday, but burial will take place some time Friday with burial in Forest Baptist Church cemetery.

Born in Nelson County July 10, 1887, Mr. White was the son of Addison Morgan and Mary Woodroof White. His wife, the former Miss Bettie Ashley, died some years ago. Surviving him are two sons and three daughters, J. E. White, G. H. White and Mrs. D. E. Davis, all of Forest; Mrs. H. L. Tinsley and Mrs. W. E. Mitchell of Lynchburg. He leaves also 29 grandchildren.
