KNOW ALL MEN that I FRANCIS TRIPLETT do acknowledge by these presents to have sold & firmly set to sale from me my heirs for ever unto JAMES GILLET & WILLIAM GIBSON & WILLIAM WEST & to them & their heirs for ever all my right & interest of the within specified land in consideration of Three thousand five hundred pounds of tobacco & cask to me in hand paid by the above sd JAMES GILLET, WILL GIBSON & WILL WEST Moreover I bind me my heirs to warrant the sale of my Wifes Dowry or Thirds to the sd Land with all just warranty that can & hereafter may be lawfully by Councell of Law devised & to the true performance hereof I hereof set my hand & seale this 10th day of October 1664

KNOW ALL MEN that I ABIGALL TRIPLET of the County of Rappa. in the Parish of Sittenbourne Wife of FRANCIS TRIPLET of the same Parish do appoint my well beloved Friend Mr. ALLEX. FLEMING my true & lawfull Attorney for me to yeald up all my right & interest of land lying upon the North side of RAPPA. RIVER bounding upon the lands of SAMLTELL NICHOLLS unto JAMES GULLOCK & WILL GIBSON & WILL WEST to the true performance thereof I have set my hand & seal the first of November (missing) presence of EDWARD ROUZEE ABIGALL TRIPLET

#### NOTES

Francis Triplett sold land on 10 Oct 1664 in Rappahannock County from to James Gillett (or Gullock), William Gibson, and William West for 3250 pounds of tobacco.

Establishes that Francis Triplett was married to Abigall by 10 Oct 1664
