Hi, Jane,

I am descended from James Dishman ⁷⁶⁹ and Peggy Ennis ⁷⁷⁰ through their daughter Mary Frances Dishman who married George J. Walters.

Other children than the ones you have listed are Daniel b. 1827 (no further info) and James b. 1838 (no further info) MAY have died young.

First wife of John Dishman was Prudence Hudson ⁸⁹⁹ who died one month after giving birth to a stillborn child. ¹²²⁶

Sarah Dishman m. Fleming Mason Galloway in 1856 and Mary Elizabeth Dishman m. Abraham Miller Galloway, Dec 19, 1854.

Parents of George Washington Ennis were John Ennis b. 1695 in Ireland. Came to the colonies in 1716 from Dublin. Settled in Amherst Co., Va, died Goochland Co., Va., m. Mary Ann Whitlock. Children of John Ennis and Mary Ann Whitlock were:
